Tips and rules

There are **two ways** of using the Waee flashcards, you can either reproduce the given sentences, following the levels of difficulty according to the lessons of the Booklet Elementary 1, or make your own sentences.

In order to make your own sentences, you have to follow some rules:

Grammar rules / how to build a sentence:

EASY sentences : article + object + color

The articles:

The article depends of the gender of the object,
If the object is masculine, the pronoun is masculine.
If the object is feminine, the pronoun is feminine.
If the object is plural, the article is plural.

A / an =

The =

Masculine	←	UN (a)	LE / L' (the)	→	Masculine L' = before a word starting with a vowel or H
Feminine	←	UNE (a)	LA / L' (the)	→	Feminine
Plural	←	DES (pl)	LES (the, pl)	→	Plural

The objects:

The objects are the words in the **blue** flashcards:
The genders of the word are given with:

Masculine =  (endings with a consonant or exception)

Feminine =  (90% ending in E)

Plural = (pl) (ending in S or X)



The color:

Colors are always placed at the **end**.

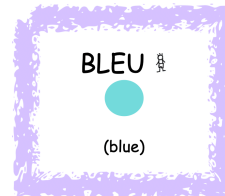
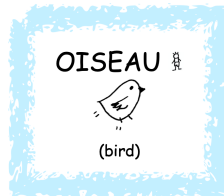
The color follows the object in gender and number.

Ex: un serpent **rouge**.

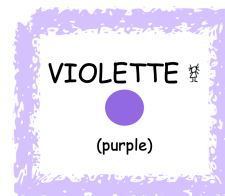
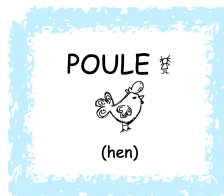

COMPLEX sentences:

subject + verb + article + object + adjective

You will need:

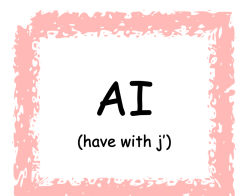
1. The subjects / pronouns in front of a verb



2. The verbs

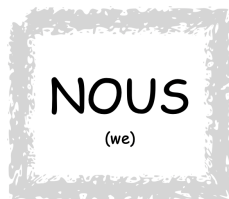
In 2nd position, we need a verb conjugated at the same person as the pronoun.

In the flashcards, you will find the verbs for the verbs **avoir** (to have), **être** (to be) and the **ER & GER** verbs.

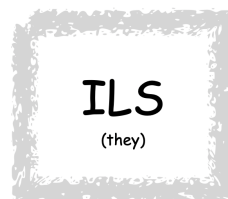

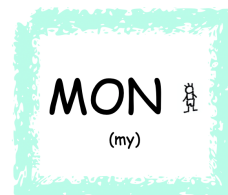

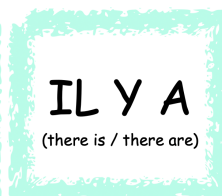
3. The articles

In 3rd position, we can use the articles for a / an = un, une, des, or the articles for the = le, la, les, l'



But we also have **the possessives**, they follow the object in gender and number.

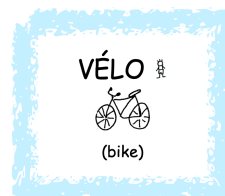

4. The objects

After the article, comes the object.

Go back to **page 2** for all the vocabulary.

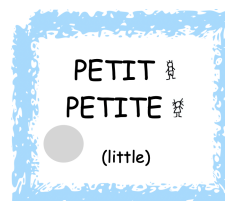


5. The adjectives

The **adjectives** can be used before or after the object / word.

If the ● is on the left, the adjective = **in front of** the object.

If the ● is on the right, the adjective = **after** the object.



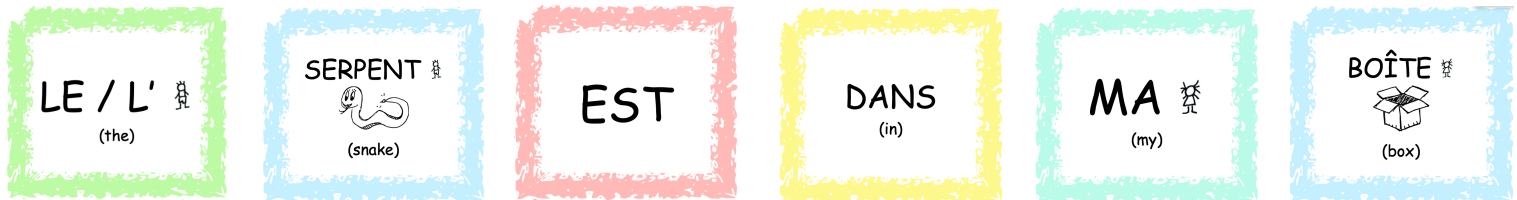
To make the sentences even more complex, we can use the prépositions of place:

6. Prepositions of place

The prepositions of place are placed **after** the verb, to indicate a location.

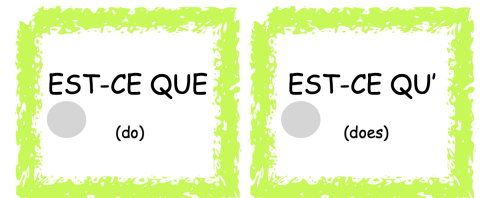
For example:

The snake is in my box.



7. Writing questions:

We use « est-ce que » = do or « est-ce qu' » = does, in order to write questions. Just add it in front of the sentence.



For example:

Do you (formal) have cherries?
